Dress Code

- Athletic Shorts
- T-shirts
- Jeans
- Sweat Shirts
- Etc.

At night, we encourage students to wear nicer clothing such as:

- Nice and modest shorts
- Slacks and Khaki Shorts
- Dresses/Skirts
- Button Downs
- Polos
- Blouses
- Etc.

If you're unsure if something is appropriate then ask an adult or team leader, or a good rule of thumb is, if you're unsure if it's appropriate then pick something else to wear.
